Guidelines for Transfer

Commonwealth Supported Place (CSP)

Guidelines for a CSP from Diploma to Deakin University* – March 2010 intake

Students who successfully complete their Diploma course at MIBT in 2009 will be eligible to apply for a CSP at Deakin University in March 2010. *Please note that no mid-year CSPs are available.*

The following transfer criteria apply:

- Students who achieve a WAM of 50% or higher in the most recently taken eight units of study, will be guaranteed a CSP at one of Deakin University's Campuses;
- Students who achieve a WAM of 65% or higher in the most recently taken eight units of study, will be guaranteed a CSP at Deakin University's Melbourne Campus at Burwood.

** **Note:** For a CSP place in the Bachelor of Laws students must apply through VTAC and will require a WAM of 80%+. Entry into the Bachelor of Laws is only available in the March intake.*

***Note:** A student enrolling in the Diploma of Commerce should not enrol in MLC101 Business Law if Law is the intended undergraduate program and full Advanced Standing (8 credits) is sought. A credit point for each Commerce unit successfully completed at MIBT will be granted up to a maximum of 8 but no credit will be granted for MLC101 (max 7 if this unit is done). Assuming that all LLB units are passed at first attempt, a student would be able to complete the LLB in 3 years (plus 1 extra semester, maybe Summer, if MLC101 had been completed at MIBT).*

*# **As of 2009, the Federal Government has eliminated undergraduate fee-paying places for new domestic students.***

How to Transfer to Deakin University

Course information sessions are held towards the end of each semester for students who will be completing their MIBT Diploma. The information sessions include details about transfer procedures.

Note: Only Australian citizens and holders of Humanitarian visas are eligible for HECS-HELP and FEE-HELP. Since the start of 2005, permanent residents and New Zealand citizens cannot defer payment of HECS/Fees.
