- 4. EVIDENCE OF AUSTRALIAN CITIZENSHIP** – Passport, Australian citizenship or birth certificate may be provided (*please bring a copy of the original*).
- 5. CONTACT DETAILS** – Australian address (including postcode) and telephone number.
- 6. A PEN**
- 7. FEE-HELP FORM** – If you are accepting your offer using FEE-HELP, please ensure you bring the completed form including your Tax File Number.

### What happens if I do not attend Orientation and Enrolment Day?

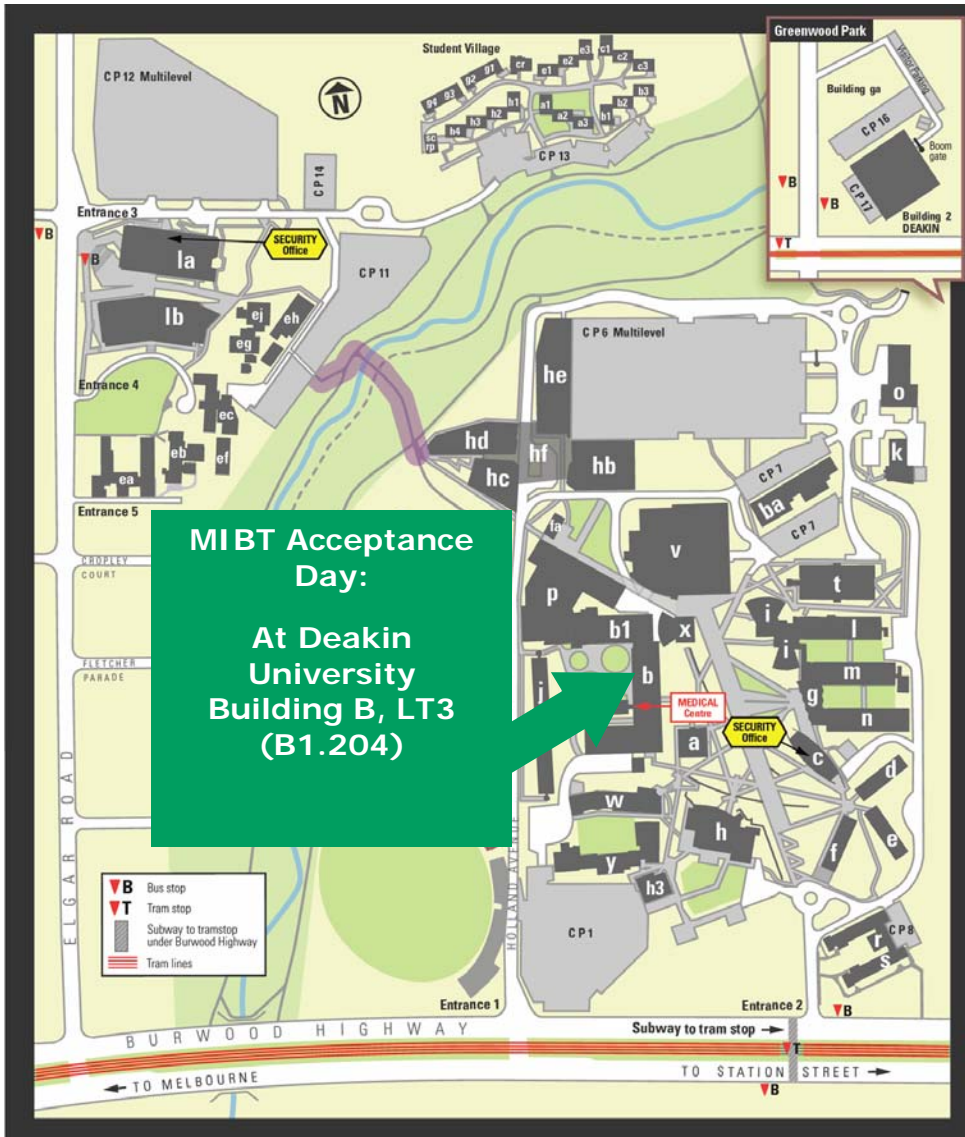
If you are not able to attend on Acceptance Day, please contact **MIBT** to receive instructions about late enrolments.

**MI BT Acceptance Day:**  
**At Deakin University Building B, LT3 (B1.204)**

**Tram**  
 The number 75 tram from Spencer Street Station or Flinders Street in the city centre stops right outside the campus on Burwood Highway. You need to make your way to Elgar road (about 5 minute walk). The number 70 tram from the city to Wattle Park is also an option.

**Bus/train**  
 Buses connect with a number of suburban train stations. Bus number 767 departs from Box Hill Station on the Lilydale/Belgrave line or Jordanville on the Glen Waverley line. Bus number 732 departs from Box Hill Station or Upper Ferntree Gully, both on the Belgrave line.

**Car**  
 Parking is available at various open-air and undercover areas on the main campus and at the Elgar Road precinct. Car parking tickets/permits are required.
